JUDGES COMMENTS:

A very nice show, where sadly the number of exhibits present on the day was to be reduced by a capricious bug in the heat of July, such that 22 milkers entered only 11 were to appear. This also led to the demise of youngstock exhibited.

There being only 4 exhibitors present my task was an easy one, with the Lyncol and Montrue herds taking best exhibits in milker, goatling and kid classes. I put Montrue Mtombili top of the IP. A BS first kidder running through with a preferred udder shape and more forward attachment than the reserve BS Montrue Maya. A tidy BA first kidder stood next.

Given so few milking goats all yields were without exception noteworthy and young stock were all well grown with sound conformation. It was a pleasure to have an enthusistic ring steward who showed a keen interest in the aspects of my judging.
