North Midlands Milk Recording Club & Quintet Milk Recording Club

The NMMRC & QMRC would like the BGS to look at the current Milk Recording Programme (MREC) with a view to bringing it up to date so that it is more "user friendly" with modern computer programs. Historically it was written for DOS then updated to a Windows based version in 2009, it has never to our knowledge had any further update and does not work well with the more current software available, there is also no back up available and if there should be any problems with the program the Secretary's would probably have to resort back to paper, pen and calculator – not an ideal situation.

Whilst in itself the programme is a very good data base and has some useful features it is very much incompatible with other software so is very "stand alone" in its application, this does not help with regard to sending emails, printing copy, inserting the data into other applications etc and as there is no connection to the BGS Grassroots system, all verification of goats details have to be done individually by hand which is time consuming.

A more modern system based on something similar the BGS Grassroots system or with access to the Grassroots database information would be of benefit to the Milk Recording Secretaries for inputting the data and creating the sample results and to the BGS in their use of the data provided to them for the officially recorded yields for milk recorded goats.
