Best coat I've seen on an English, short and shiny. Walked very wide. She didn't have the body of a Swiss type but being English you wouldn't expect it. Nice underneath so I really hope for her when the udder comes down. I've seen some good English this year but Topgold Mushroom easily the best and certainly deserved Best Kid.
